Rules

The rules of the Finnish Orienteering Federation as well as instructions given by the organizer and the International Orienteering Federation will be applied in the competition. The rules of The Finnish Orienteering Federation are available on the website www.suunnistusliitto.fi.

Classes

Classes M21E and W21E have WRE status. Same time is national orienteering competition with classes H/D4-85 and open motion orienteering.

The competition is also a selection race for Finnish team to JEC, JWOC and EYOC in classes H/D16E, H/D18E and H/D20E.

Punching system

Emit punching system will be in use.

Entries and entry fees

Entries should be made primarily through IRMA (competitors with Finnish license & club) or Eventor service. If neither of the above doesn't work, entries can be made via email: kilpailut.tp@gmail.com

Entry fee for WRE competitors is 30 €.

Emit card number must be included in the entry. The need for a rental Emit card has to be indicated in the entry. If Emit card number is missing, the organizer will reserve an Emit card and charge 3 €.
